

Adult Volunteer Opportunities in Children's Ministry

Leading : River Explorers Workshops for grades 1-5 –create one workshop from scheduled curriculum. Present the same lesson two consecutive Sundays; once to children in grades 1-3 and once to children in grades 4-5.
Six week term; Sundays may not be consecutive

Teaching:

kindergarten (8 week term)

Middle School (grades 6-8)
(3 Sundays on, 1 Sunday off for 6 weeks)

High School (grades 9-12)
(3 Sundays on, 1 Sunday off for Sept – Dec; March – May)

Other Special Events and Activities:

Lead Chalice Worship (11:00-11:15 Sunday mornings except 1st Sunday of month)

Lead First Sunday “Green” Projects (11:15-12:00 on first Sunday of each month)

Sponsor youth groups, Middle School Adventure Club or Young Religious UUs
(Circle either Middle School or High School)

Back to school party (last Sunday in August)

Trunk or Treat (Sunday closest to Halloween)

Nifty Gifty (crafts and gift making first Saturday in Dec)

Spring Reading Program (assist in children's library)

Easter Egg Hunt (supervise)

Chair of June Service Project (recruit, plan, and execute one project each year, last 3 Sundays in June)

Serve on the Children's Ministry Team (works with DRE to implement programming, meets monthly to plan)
